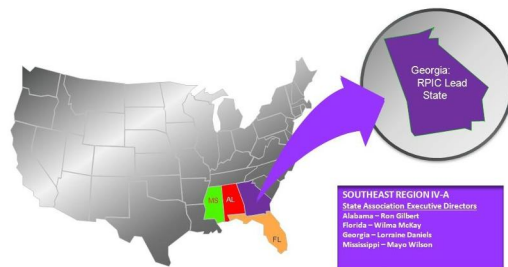

### Nationally Certified ROMA Trainer (NCRT)

The Regional Cohort (RPIC IVA) will be implementing an NCRT Phase II, October 9, 10, 11, 2018. All interested individuals must complete an application by August 10, 2018; and the e-course before September 28, 2018 to qualify to participate.

### Nationally Certified ROMA Professionals (NCRPs)

The ROMA 2018 Fall In-service Continuing Education Program (ICEP) for Nationally Certified ROMA Trainers and Implementer October 23-24, 2018.

\*The fall 2018 session will be held in Las Vegas, NV. The spring 2019 session will be in Oklahoma City, OK, and fall 2019 in Region 1 (location not yet established). The sessions will move around the country so that NCRT's and NCRI's have at least one out of six ICEPs (two each year in the three year re-certification time frame) being held at a location near to them for ease of travel.
